## 10 Steps to Filling Your Room with Your Signature Style

STEP 7:	Create a Concept Board of Pieces

 Gather many, many images that reflect your style for each of the needed pieces found on your zone worksheet on a second Pinterest Board entitled <u>"Room" Concept Board</u>. You can do this using search words. Don't worry about cost at this point but we are still working on a vision.

Fabric + Piece

**STEP 8: Incorporate Balance** - Whittle down your images to reflect a balanced room using the design elements of color, shape, texture, print, finish and weight as to not distract from the focal point. Symmetry around the focal point is one way to accomplish this balance. The way to achieve balance is to spread similar design elements on different sides of the room to create cohesiveness and to draw the eye around the room.

- I. First create balance through color.
- II. Then balance textures by distributing similar patterns and textures within the color and furniture elements.
- III. Keep in mind the type of line is in your design style (curve, straight or both) when choosing lighting.

**STEP 9: Choose your actual pieces** within your budget based on your balanced vision.

STEP 10: Choose Art and Décor adding texture and balance
